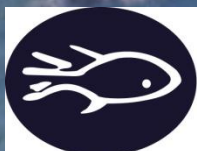
## Fall 2010 He'eia Ahupua'a Internship

Paepae o He'eia and Papahana Kuaola, two He'eia-based organizations, are partnering together to offer a 13-week fall internship. The He'eia Ahupua'a Internship, a 16 hour per week internship will provide 6 young adults (ages 18-30), a unique opportunity to work outdoors and learn skills important to restore, preserve and protect resources within an ahupua'a. The concept behind this internship is to nurture the mauka/makai ahupua'a relationship. Work will include: fishpond restoration, aquaculture activities, native plant propagation, lo'i (taro terrace) restoration and stream restoration. In addition to physical work, participants will gain knowledge about wahi pana (place names) and cultural sites within Ko'olaupoko as well as information regarding native and non-native plant and animal species.
