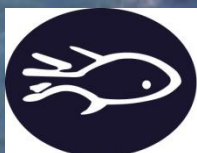
2011-2012 He'eia Ahupua'a Internship

Paepae o He'eia is changing up the internship this year! We are offering a year-round internship which will run from September to May. The He'eia Ahupua'a Internship is a 16 hour per week internship and will provide 3 adults (ages 18-30), a unique opportunity to work outdoors and learn skills important to restore, preserve and protect resources within the ahupua'a system. The concept behind this internship is to nurture the mauka/makai ahupua'a relationship. Work will include: fishpond restoration, aquaculture activities, native plant propagation, lo'i (taro terrace) restoration and stream restoration. In addition to physical work, participants will gain knowledge about wahi pana (place names) and cultural sites within the Ko'olaupoko moku as well as information regarding native and non-native plant and animal species.
